

Accessibility to the environment at Wilden Primary.

All Special Education Needs children are given the opportunity to participate fully in the life of the school. We aim for all pupils to access the full curriculum, with activities and educational off-site visits differentiated to support children with all levels of ability, including those with sensory or physical difficulties. This will always be done through liaison and consultation with parents, carers and pupils and with the appropriate specialist agency. The school has staff trained to suit children with a range of needs. Extra curricular activities and after school provision is accessible to all children including those with SEN.

Access to the school buildings, is assisted by handrails, ramps allowing wheelchair access from the lower playground to the hall entrance and nursery, and by ramps from the upper playground to the Reception Class, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3. There are ramps allowing access to Year 4 and 5 at the rear of the school. There is a stair lift to allow access from the hall to the reception class level. There is a lift from the Reception class level to Year 6. In order to accommodate the needs of the physically handicapped child, a bathroom management area is available opposite the Reception class. Outdoor steps are painted white for visually impaired children. We ensure that equipment is accessible to all children regardless of their needs. Specialised provisions will be put in place to meet the needs of identified children. These may include work stations, writing slopes, sitting wedges or adapted stationary.
