

Agencies and individuals that provide support for children with SEN
at Wilden Primary

At Wilden we work with a wide range of specialist agencies to support the needs of all of our children. Parents are always consulted before any referral to an outside agency is made.

If there are ongoing concerns about SEN pupils the SENCO will discuss these at the School Support Team Meeting which is held each term. At these meetings support and advice is sought from the representatives of the Learning Support Team, the Educational Psychology Service and the Speech and Language Therapy Service. Referrals can also be made to Specialist Support Services which includes the Autism Outreach Service and the Behaviour Support Service, the Disability Outreach Service which includes teams for Hearing and Visual impairment, Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy. The school also has the support of the school nurse and a Home School Link Worker.

The school always respects the advice and information given by these services and will share it with the parents/carers before any intervention programmes or further action is taken.
