

How staff at Wilden are supported to work with children with SEN

At Wilden all pupils experience excellent targeted classroom teaching known as "Quality First Teaching". We believe that all staff should be involved in supporting pupils with special educational needs and ensure staff have training to help them do this. In each Key Stage the teachers are supported by highly skilled Teaching Assistants who deliver interventions across a range of needs. As part of our Continuing Professional Development, all staff attend training events and consult with specialist support agencies to enhance the provision for pupils at our school. Individual teachers and support staff attend training courses run by outside agencies that are relevant to the needs of specific children in their class.

The SENCO supports staff in planning and delivering intervention programmes for SEN pupils. She delivers in house training ensuring that all staff are informed of the latest developments and resources for SEN. Staff are also able to learn from each other: regularly passing on strategies that have worked well.
