Supporting children who are looked after by the local authority and have SEN.

Our school does everything possible to maximise educational stability for Looked After children including those who have SEN. High expectations are set for the learning and educational progress of these pupils and although they may need more support than other children as a result of previous experiences, the school does not allow this to be an excuse for lowering the expectations of what the child is capable of achieving.

The SENCO is the designated teacher who has responsibility for supporting staff to understand the things which can affect how Looked After children learn and achieve. Everyone involved in helping looked after children is made aware of the emotional, psychological and social effects of previous experiences, though these events are kept confidential.

The designated teacher (SENCO) develops the Personal Education Plan (PEP) which forms part of the overall care plan for Looked After children. The PEP ensures the child gets the support and provision needed to succeed in school. The SENCO monitors the educational, social and emotional needs of the Looked After child and liaises with the carers and various agencies on a regular basis.
